CHANGES TO THE STRATEGIC GOODS CONTROL LIST

Updates to the Strategic Goods Control List

Singapore Customs would like to inform you that the new **Strategic Goods (Control) Order 2021** ("SGCO 2021") has been gazetted on 2 August 2021 and will come into effect from **1 October 2021**. You may access the SGCO 2021 via our website at www.customs.gov.sg > Businesses > Strategic Goods Control > Strategic Goods Control List.

- The SGCO 2021 brings Singapore's strategic goods control list up to date with the 2020 European Union's List of Dual-Use Items ("EUDL"). The EUDL contains dual-use items controlled by the four multilateral export control regimes (the Australia Group, the Missile Technology Control Regime, the Nuclear Suppliers Group and the Wassenaar Arrangement). There are no changes made to the Wassenaar Arrangement's Munitions List.
- The SGCO 2021 will incorporate revisions such as new controls, as well as editorial changes for consistency and clarity of controls. A document on the amendments can be found via our website at www.customs.gov.sg > Businesses > Strategic Goods Control > Resources.

Amendment to the Strategic Goods (Control) Brokering Order 2019

- An amendment will be made to the Strategic Goods (Control) Regulations to reflect its reference to the new SGCO 2021. There are <u>no</u> changes to the scope of brokering controls.
- 5 The Strategic Goods (Control) (Brokering) (Amendment) Order 2021 will come into effect from **1 October 2021**.

<u>Amendment to the Strategic Goods (Control) Regulations</u>

An amendment will be made to the Strategic Goods (Control) Regulations to reflect its reference to the new SGCO 2021. Please note that 1C350.65 has been

added to the list of items controlled for transhipment and transit (i.e. 4th and 5th Schedules).

7 The Strategic Goods (Control) (Amendment) Regulations 2021 will come into effect from **1 October 2021**.
